

**Guidelines for Admission to various B.Tech. Programs at HBTU,  
Kanpur for session 2019-20 (Offline-On Campus Counseling)**

1. Admissions will be made on basis of merit of **JEE (Main)-2019**. Detailed guidelines related to admission are also available on University website [www.hbtu.ac.in](http://www.hbtu.ac.in)
2. Candidates are advised to read these guidelines carefully, check their eligibility before filling and submitting the Online Registration Form.
3. The University shall conduct its own Counselling on the basis of merit of **JEE (Mains) 2019** with following academic eligibility:

The candidate must have **clearly passed (10 + 2) qualifying examination** from U.P. Board or its equivalent from any other recognized Board / University with a minimum of five subjects in which **Physics and Mathematics are compulsory subjects** alongwith **one of the subjects** from **Chemistry/ Biotechnology/ Biology/ Technical Vocational** subjects. Candidates must obtain at least 60% marks (55% for reserved category candidates, SC/ST/OBC-NCL/PH) in aggregate in above three subjects. In addition, all other eligibility conditions for appearing in JEE (Mains)- 2019 Examination shall be applicable to the candidates.
4. A Candidate who is domicile of Uttar Pradesh, i.e. he / she has passed the 10+2 qualifying examination from Institution located in U.P. is eligible for counselling. In case, the candidate has passed qualifying examination from outside UP, he / she has to produce Permanent Residence Certificate of his / her parents (Father or Mother). Candidates who are wards of Defence Personnel settled or posted in UP on the date of Entrance Examination of **JEE (Mains) 2019** or Officers / Employees of All India Services belonging to UP Cadre are also eligible. They are required to produce Certificate No. 10 .
5. Accepting admission in HBTU, Kanpur implies the acceptance by the candidate parents or guardians of all the terms and conditions laid down by the University. Any change in the rules, regulations, fee and other specific conditions etc. of the University shall apply mutatis mutandis to the admitted candidates.
6. Candidates must note that all the seats in Offline-On Campus Counseling are open and no reservation is applicable on it. However, the seats will be filled on the merit of JEE (Mains) 2019 CRL Rank of the candidate.
7. The candidates for whom the result of the qualifying examination has not been declared till the date of the Document Verification due to any reason, whatsoever, shall not be eligible for admission under any circumstances.
8. Original certificates are to be produced at the time of Document Verification along with one self-attested copy of each document. Formats for various certificates to be submitted are available on the University website. These formats are subject to change as per the orders of Government of Uttar Pradesh.
9. If any document / declaration submitted by the candidate are found to be false at any stage, his / her admission will be cancelled and he / she may be liable for prosecution under the law. In case of any legal dispute, the jurisdiction will be limited to Kanpur Court only.
10. The candidates must ensure their eligibility for admission to B.Tech. programs at HBTU Kanpur while applying. University will not be responsible for any error of judgments on the

part of the candidate.

11. Academic Fee deposited by the candidates will be forfeited and any request for withdrawal / refund will not be entertained under any circumstances.
12. In case, Board / University awards only letter grades for qualifying examination without providing an equivalent percentage of marks, the candidate should obtain a certificate from the Board / University specifying equivalent marks and submit it at the time of Document Verification. In case, such a certificate is not provided by the candidate, the decision of the Admission Committee regarding his / her eligibility shall be final.
13. The allotment of seats through counselling will be carried out strictly on JEE (Mains) 2019 merit of the candidate subject to the order of choice preference given for the seat and the availability of seat.
14. All the information in connection with B.Tech. Admission 2019 shall be made available through the website: [www.hbtuadmission.nic.in](http://www.hbtuadmission.nic.in) and <http://www.hbtu.ac.in>. The candidates are advised to visit these websites frequently. University will not be responsible for any loss to the candidate due to the lack of communication.

### 15. Medical Standards

- a) Candidates will have to submit a certificate of Medical Fitness / Physically Handicapped certificate (Certificate no. 8) at the time of Document Verification.
- b) The medical standards prescribed are given below:

Height	Candidates should be physically fit to pursue his / her studies in opted course.

Heart and lungs	No abnormality
Hernia, Hydrocele, Piles etc.	Presence of any of these is to be corrected before joining
Vision	Normal, if defective, it must be got corrected to 6/9 in the better eye and 6/12 in the worse one. Eyes should be free from congenital or any other disease
Hearing	Normal, If defective, it must be got corrected before joining.

#### Physically Handicapped / Disabled:

Physically Handicapped / Disabled persons of Uttar Pradesh will have a minimum of 5% reservation on the basis of impairment and mentioned below:

Type I	Minimum 40% permanent Visual impairment
Type II	Minimum 40% permanent Locomotors disability
Type III	Minimum 40% permanent speech and Hearing impairment
